

SCOUT DAY CHECK-IN 2022

The Scout Day event is held at **Bear Mountain** located at **43101 Goldmine Dr., Big Bear Lake, CA 92315**.

The rental shop at **Bear Mountain** will open at **6:30AM** Sunday for the Scouts ONLY. If you want to pick up equipment Saturday, March 5, day before pick-up is from 4:30PM - 6:30PM. Arrival after 6:30PM will not be accommodated. *Please plan accordingly with traffic and lodging check-in.* We will have many Scouts so it is important that you have all your RENTAL VOUCHERS ready so we can process everyone in a timely manner.

PARKING The parking lot will be open at 6AM and is first come first serve.
There is no charge for parking this season.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

- ✓ Merit Badge Counselors helping with this event will check in at the Scout Rally Point to receive their comp ticket.
- ✓ ALL tickets will have been shipped to the group leader to pass out to their Troop prior to arrival.
 - **All sales are final.** NO EXCEPTIONS.

LESSON INFORMATION

- ✓ Scouts in the Adventurers or Explorers Program – Check-in outside the Adventure Academy, which opens at 8AM. The staff will check them in and take their equipment for lesson times starting at 9AM. Once they are checked in an adult will bring them to the meeting area for lesson time.
- ✓ All Scouts in Explorer or Adventurer lessons must be checked-out by an Adult. Scouts in Adult lessons will be released at the end of class without an adult pickup.

RENTAL INFORMATION

- ✓ An adult must be with the scouts/minors to sign the equipment waiver. No, this does not have to be their parent.

IMPORTANT: Scouts and children in the Adventurers, Explorers programs MUST go through the rental department first at **6:30AM** Sunday to make their 9AM lessons. Late arrivals will not be accepted into lessons after they start, and **no refunds will be given.** **BE PREPARED!**
